What are the Emmaus solidarity work camps in Europe ?

Every year from April to October, certain European groups host volunteers aged 18 and over for stays lasting between one week and two months.

The aim of the solidarity work camp is to enable young people to discover the values of the Emmaus Movement and the people involved in it. In addition, it is also the chance for men and women from different backgrounds to get to know one another.

During their stay, European volunteers are integrated into the group and take part in its daily life – they get involved in the activities: collecting, salvaging, recycling and selling goods and the life of the community depending on their skills: eating with the companions and cleaning duties...

Work camps for every taste

- If you are keen and willing to take part in the activities proposed and discover the Emmaus movement... Register now, you will be working to your own abilities, there is work for everyone!
- If you have special skills to offer in building, carpentry, masonry, painting, electrical work, plumbing etc., let us know what they are!

Practical information

The hosting group covers all of the costs incurred by the presence of the young volunteers, accommodation and food.

However, volunteers are asked to cover their travel expenses (to and from the group) and any medical or other personal costs.

You need to take out your own insurance.

Accommodation

Every camp is different and accommodation varies (in tents, hardwall accommodation, in the community etc). Information about what you need to bring is available on the host group's website or will be provided by the contact person once you have registered.

Register

Visit Emmaus Europe's website:

Select the work camp of your choice, taking into account the camp dates, and click on the country tabs to obtain the relevant information.

In some cases, you can register online for the camps via the host group's website, while in other cases, you will need to complete a registration form and send it to the contact person listed.
